



## BEVEL EDGE WAIVER FORM

WINNISQUAM WOOD PRODUCTS HAS MANUFACTURED COUNTER TOPS USING ALL OF THE MAJOR LAMINATE COMPANIES' MATERIAL INCLUDING PIONITE, WILSONART, FORMICA, AND NEVAMAR. THEY DESIGN THEIR LINE TO ACCOMMODATE A RANGE OF THEIR MARKETS AND CONTINUE TO MANUFACTURE A WIDE ARRAY OF LAMINATE COLORS INCLUDING DARK SOLIDS IN BOTH MATTE/SUEDE FINISH AND HIGH GLOSS FINISH.

\*\*\*\* PLEASE NOTE \*\*\*\*

- DARK SOLID COLORS tend to show more wear. Although dark solids are more dramatic and add contrast, they always show scratches and wear immediately and are not recommended for kitchen counter tops.
- LIGHT COLORS will show the black line. These should be avoided, or a contrasting bevel color can be chosen.
- GLOSS FINISH is appropriate for bathroom vanity counter tops ONLY. In higher traffic areas such as kitchens, it is not recommended. Scratches, fingerprints, etc. are highly visible !!
- Because we do not use bevel sticks, and is a *custom made* product, it is virtually impossible to have the bevel line up perfectly with the rest of the laminate.

IT IS OUR OPINION BASED ON YEARS OF MANUFACTURING THAT THESE COLOR LAMINATES AND FINISHES ARE VIRTUALLY IMPOSSIBLE TO MANUFACTURE WITHOUT NOTICEABLE SCRATCHING OR DEFECTS. THEREFORE, IT IS OUR INTENTION TO WARN OUR CLIENTS AND THEIR CUSTOMERS OF THE NATURE OF THESE PRODUCTS PRIOR TO ORDERING THEIR COUNTERTOPS AND WAIVE WINNISQUAM WOOD PRODUCTS' RESPONSIBILITY FOR SUCH OCCURRENCES.
